- **<u>Academic Achievement</u>**: How has this student maximized his/her abilities to demonstrate a commitment to succeed in the pursuit of their goals?
- <u>Character References</u>: Testimonies and references from a variety of supporters; including teachers, coaches, clergy, mentors, employers & others who have influenced their life.
- **Financial Need**: Does the scholarship contribute to a student's ability to afford the tuition and fees at the school of his/her choice?
